

## Bass In The Hood Tournament Rules Urban Angler Club Los Angeles

- Lifeguard approved PFD must be worn during the tournament while on your watercraft, or while in the water (wading) at all times. an exception while changing clothing will be allowed only if it is safe.
- Only small watercraft are allowed for the tournament this will include kayaks, float tubes, paddle boards, small boats under 12' in length with electric motors, etc. No gas motors. Please contact the tournament director if your Watercraft is questionable.
- wading is legal for the tournament as long as your craft is in site and most be in the background of photo if fished is measured. Wading must also be allowed by the lake.
- Competitors can not share their catch unless other wise stated in team events
- the minimum length of and limit of your catch will be determined at each event
- **Hawg Trough Bump Board** is the required measuring board for all Bass In The Hood Tournaments unless otherwise stated
- all fees must be paid before the start of any Bass In The Hood Tournament or Urban fishing Club event.
- Fish may be netted with assistance
- **photos of catch must be taken by the angler who caught the fish**
- Competitors may share equipment, including measuring boards but if cameras are shared each competitor must be logged in to their own page on the Application being used
- Tardy competitors can still participate in tournament only if the tournament fees have already been paid.
- No payment will be excepted after the start of the event
- No drinking alcohol are illegal drugs will be allowed
- All DFW and lake rules most be followed violators will be disqualified for the event
- anyone ticketed by any official police agency for violating any lake or park rules will be disqualified
- Only photos of fish caught during the allotted tournament time at the event will be eligible
- Any competitor caught cheating, manipulation catch or measuring device will be banned for life from competing in any Bass In The Hood event or any Urban Fishing Club events will be ridiculed on social media and have to answer to state laws for their violation
- Professional fishing guides can compete but may not guide during the tournament
- Bass will be measured from head to tail, mouth closed against bump board, facing left, and rounding down to the nearest 1/4 inch. tail may be inched or fanned.
- bass caught are to be photographed and released immediately and then submitted.
- All competitors most do their best to be a good sportsmen and have a good time Bass In The Hood and Urban Fishing Club do not guarantee a good time. thats up to you.
