

# Hook, Line, and Paddle Charity Kayak & Sup Fishing Tournament

## Terms and Conditions

- 1. Refunds-** If the tournament is cancelled your registration fee will carry over to next year. No refunds will be processed.
- 2. Cheating-** If you are planning on cheating let the tournament director know ahead of time to save yourself the embarrassment. After the tournament, if there is sufficient proof of you cheating you will be black-listed from all Hook, Line, and Paddle Tournaments and will have to make a \$5,000 donation to the charity being sponsored. Any angler, if directed by the tournament committee, must submit to a polygraph test within 72 hours after the last fish has been weighed. This decision is at the sole discretion of the tournament committee. Should the test be failed or if the angler fails to participate in the polygraph test within the 72 hours, the tournament committee reserves the right to forfeit all winnings awarded to the winner in question. 31. All protests made to the tournament committee shall be accompanied by a \$250 cash deposit. All protests shall be made no later than one hour after the last fish has been weighed. The \$250 cash deposit will be returned if the tournament committee upholds the protest. The \$250 cash deposit will become the property of the charity being supported if the protest is not upheld. All decisions of the tournament committee shall be final.
- 3. Responsibilities-** All participants are responsible for reading and following all rules and regulations set forth by the Hook, Line, and Paddle Charity Kayak & Sup Fishing Tournament. All participants must attend the mandatory captain's meeting. All participants must read and print the waiver and liability sheets, initial by each number and sign and date in the appropriate fields. Each angler is responsible for bringing their own completed waiver to the captain's meeting in order to fish in the tournament. If you are one of the anglers unable to make the captain's meeting, your proxy will have to supply your completed paperwork for you. Your proxy is also responsible for relaying any information covered at the captains meeting.
- 4. Media-** By paying the entry fee, the participant consents that Tidewaters, LLC or Cape Fear River Watch may use without payment or restrictions any photographs in which he or she appears for any purpose whatsoever, including but not limited to resale, advertising, commercial, or promotional material.
- 5. Makeup date-** If weather prevents the tournament from happening on July 25, 2020 then July 26, 2020 will be the make up day.
